Outline for Detail Drawings: Each Drawing is 5% of final grade

Note:

- 1. There are five (5) drawings to be manually drafted and each worth 5% of your final grade. Therefore the five detail drawings are worth 25% of your final grade.
- 2. Copies of the Detail Drawings are on Blackboard. Please note that the details cannot be traced as the sizes and proportions assigned are different from those on the sheets.
- 3. Manually draw each detail drawing assigned at scale: 1-1/2'' = 1'-0'' on $11'' \times 17''$ paper.
- 4. Where rigid insulation is noted on each detail, draw the rigid insulation as a grid instead of the solid hatch symbol as shown on the assignment sheets.
- 5. Detail drawings are to be submitted at the start of the class on the date that the detail drawing is due. Dates are listed on the course syllabus
- 6. Text: Material labels on drawing = 1/8" high and title block text = 3/16" (actual sizes)
